

ITEK CELEBRATES GOLDEN JUBILEE

The Institute of Teacher Education Kyambogo had its humble origin in a small Government Teacher Training Collage.

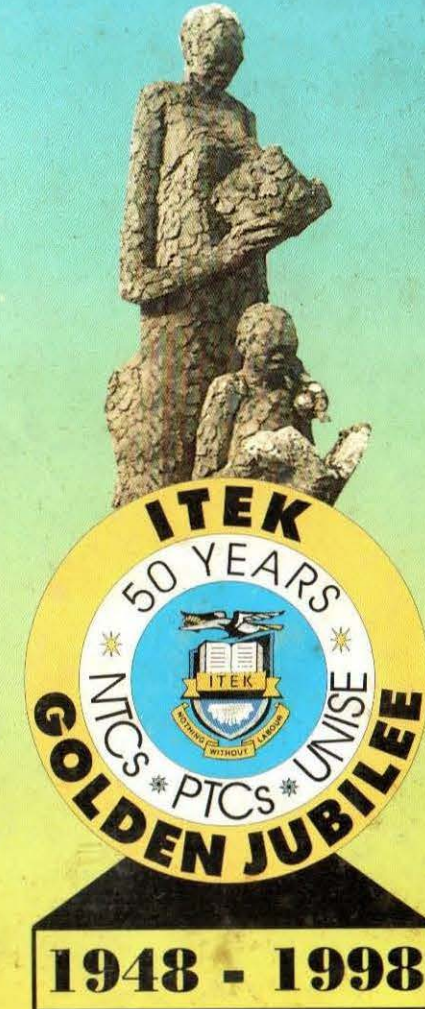
- ◆ 1948 The British Protectorate Government established a Government Teacher Training Collage, GTTC, at Nyakasura in Kabarole District. The function of the GTTC was to train Grade III Teachers for the then Junior Secondary Schools.
- ◆ 1949 The GTTC was transferred to Ruharo Hill in Mbarara; with the same functions.
- ◆ 1952 The Collage was moved to Ntare Hill Mbarara.
- ◆ 1954 The Collage was transferred to Kyambogo Hill. It had finally come to settle!
- ◆ 1956 A Domestic Science Collage, DSC, was transferred from Nsube Mukono District to Kyambogo. The DSC evolved into the present Department of Home Economics.



- ◆ 1965 The functions and status of the GTTC were elevated. The GTTC became a National Teacher's Collage, (NTC). The NTC started training Grade V Teachers (Diploma holders).
- ◆ 1985 Makerere university took over Kyambogo Campus and established a School of Education. This experiment was short lived and ended in 1986.
- ◆ 1986 ITEk was born on paper; without any legal status.
- ◆ 1989 ITEK was established by a statute of Parliament but the DATE of ASSENT was 1987.
- ◆ 1998 This is the GOLDEN YEAR!

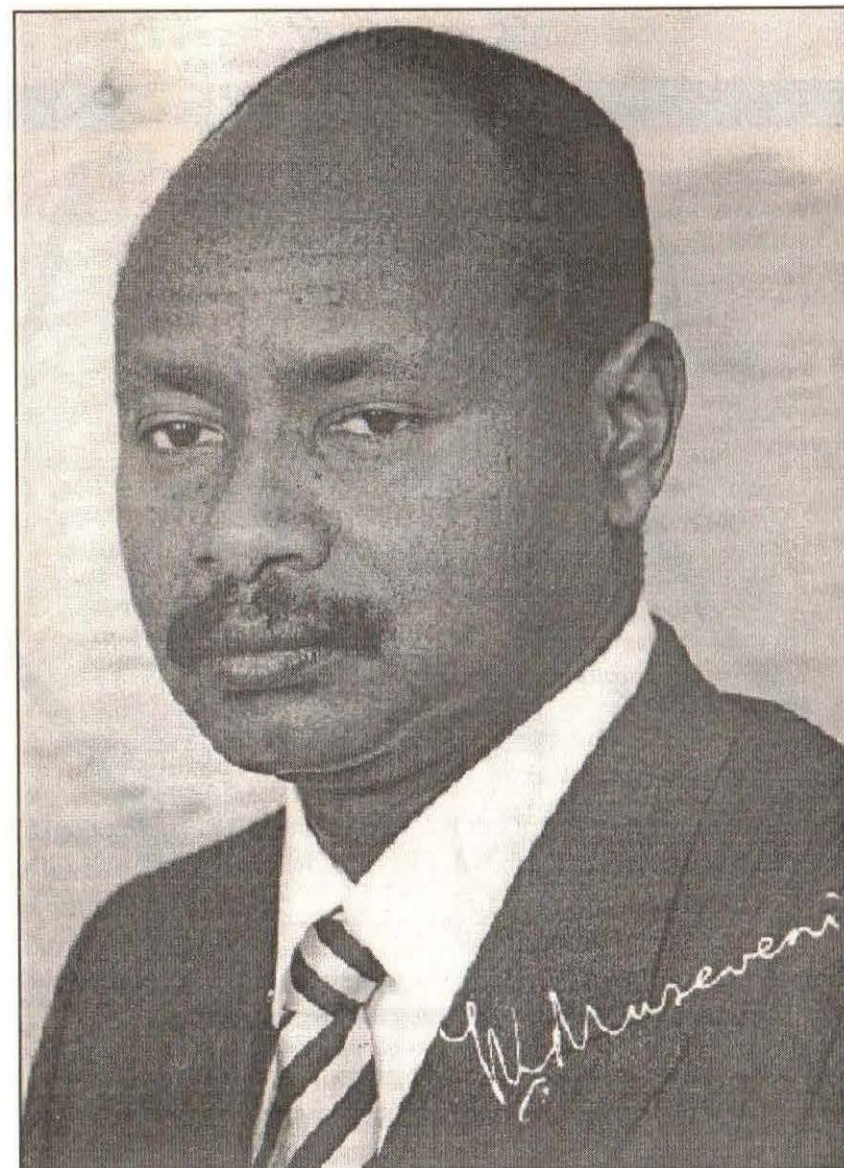

May I in a special way thank all the Alumni who braved the rains and came to attend the first ever General Meeting of ITEK Alumni on Saturday 10/1/98.

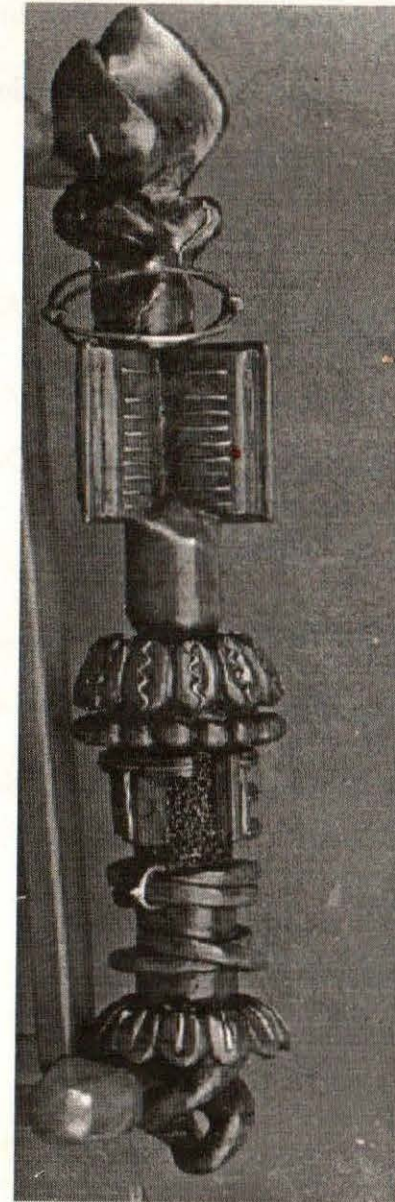

ONE MODEL OF THE ITEK ALUMNI

The Government Teacher Training College GTTC, which was started at Nyakasura 1948 evolved over years into the present Institute of Teacher Education, Kyambogo. It started with one member of Staff Mr. E. W. Kiggundu who is now working with the Kabaka of Buganda's Government

and with one cook who doubled as a night watchman. The Principal was Mr. F.K. Wood.



The College began with only 15 students. Student Number one in the register was Mr. Juma Balimutajjo who was later to be an Education Officer in Toro in the 1970s. The GTTC grew vertically and horizontally and has produced eminent people in education and other disciplines. One example is Prof. J.P. Ocitti a Professor of Education at Makerere University School of Education.

Prof. Jakayo Peter Ocitti

- ☞ First Chairman of ITEK Appointments Board 1990 - 1997.
- ☞ Was a student teacher at Kyambogo Government Teacher Training College for two years - 1958 and 1959.
- ☞ Taught for two and a half years as a Junior Secondary School Teacher.
- ☞ 1962/63 joined Oxford University and qualified as a Teacher Educator (tutor).
- ☞ 1963 - 1966 pursued his undergraduate B. Ed degree at Makerere University and got it.
- ☞ 1968 became a Lecturer - Primary Methods at Makerere University.
- ☞ 1972 obtained a Masters' degree in Geography at Makerere University
- ☞ 1978 obtained a Ph.D in the Cultural Foundations of education (Dar-es-Salaam University).
- ☞ 1979 Appointed Associated Professor and afterwards became a full Professor of Education.

Prof. Ocitti was the first Chairman of ITEK Appointments Board. He held the position up to 1997. His Board had the formidable task of restructuring and appointing staff to meet the demands of the new status of Kyambogo, now ITEK. He is one of the many great citizens who belong to ITEK Alumni.

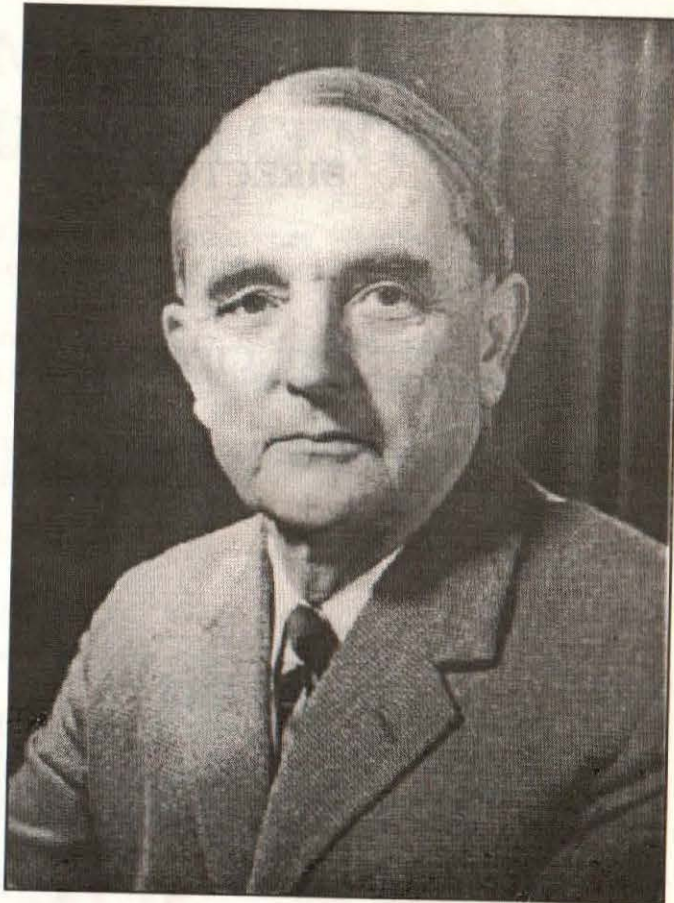

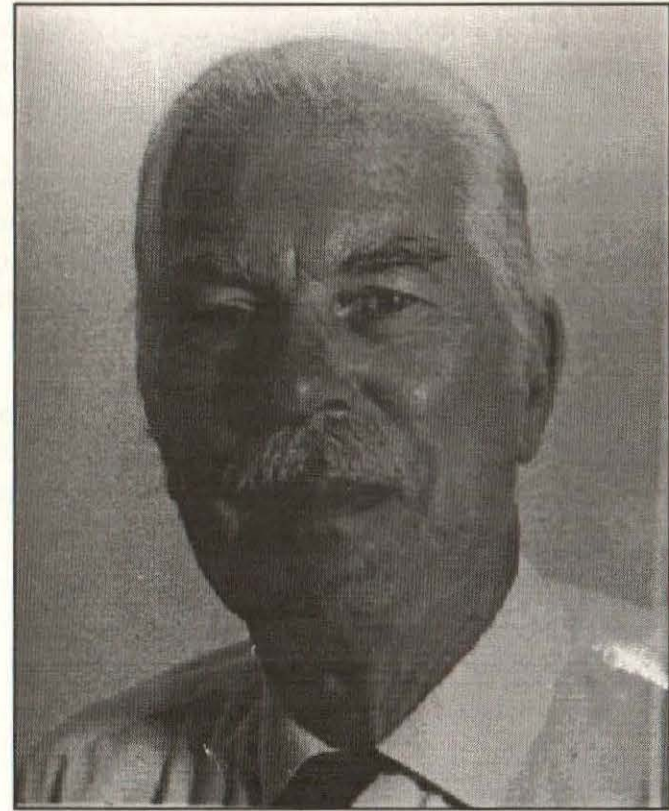

Mr. Whitehead was the Principal of the GTTC Kyambogo from 1954 - 1965. 1954 was the year when the College was transferred from Ntare Hill to Kyambogo. It was during the time of Mr. Whitehead that the Domestic Science Administration was merged with the GTTC one in 1963. He was Principal till 1965 when the GTTC was elevated to the National Teachers' College Status.

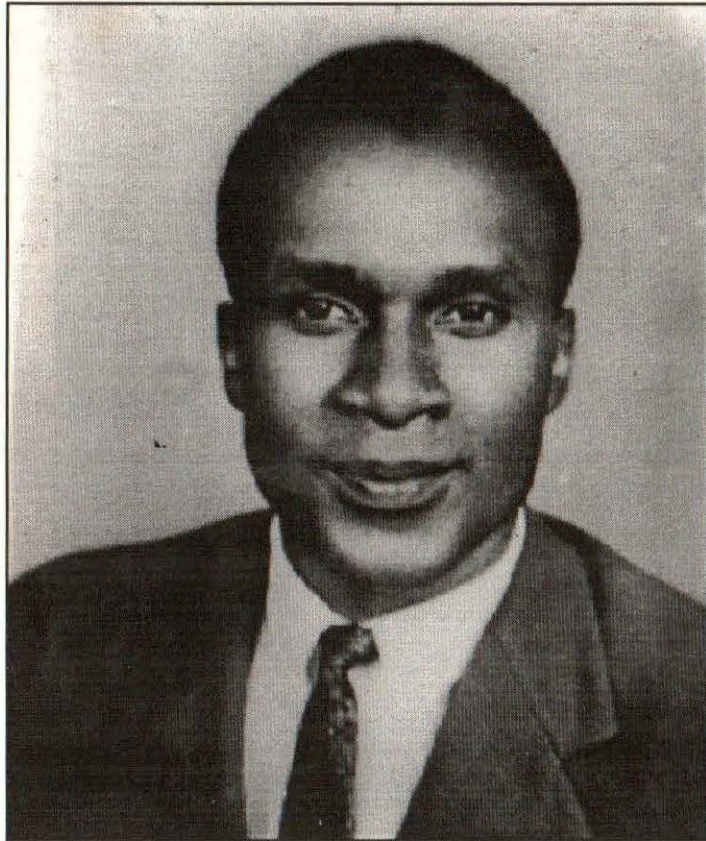

Mr. F.R. Poskitt C.B.E, M.A
Director 1966 - 1971

Mr. Poskitt was the first Director of Kyambogo NTC. In 1966 it was decided that the head of this institution should not be called Principal as had been the case previously. The head would be entitled **Director**

This is a period that saw NTC Kyambogo expand on its intake. The Grade V teachers course which used to be conducted in borrowed buildings at Makerere University had been transferred to Kyambogo in the previous year, 1965, and the GTTC was phased out. The functions of the GTTC were transferred to other Colleges in the country.



Dr. A. K. Tiberondwa
B.Sc., Bip. Ed. Dip. Educ. Admin., M.A. Ph.D.
Director Kyambogo NTC - 1971 - 1972.

Dr. Tiberondwa was the first Ugandan (African) Director of Kyambogo NTC. One of his hopes was to double the number of women teachers the college was producing. Thus on Saturday 29th January 1972 a new Women's Hostel was opened.

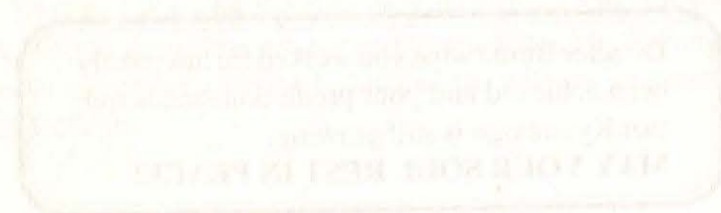
At that time Kyambogo NTC had no legal status. Whereas Makerere University was responsible for the Diploma Award, it was nowhere stated in the Makerere University Kampala Act. The Ministry of Education was

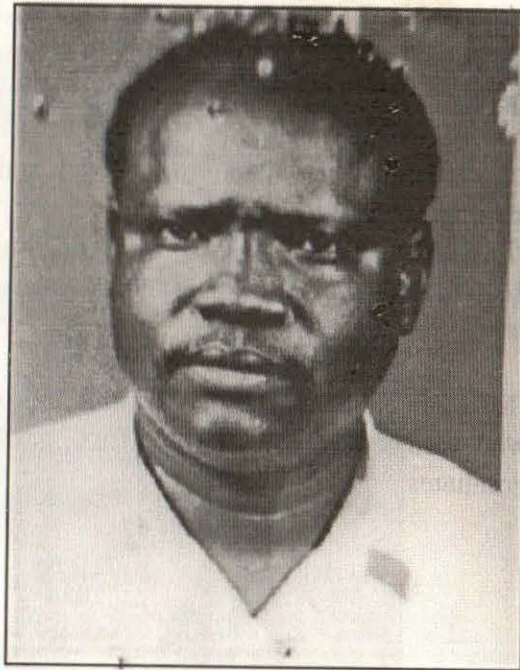
supporting the NTC but via Makerere University. The Director depending on his own choice could work in consultation with Makerere University or the Ministry of Education or could opt to consult no one!

Dr. Tiberondwa called for a legal status for Kyambogo NTC and recognition of its existence.

“Perhaps the only reason we can advance for our existence is that we do in fact exist, and are performing an extremely valuable function” he said.

He further called for improved conditions of service for non-expatriate staff who were very few and avenues for upgrading Grade V teachers to become graduates.



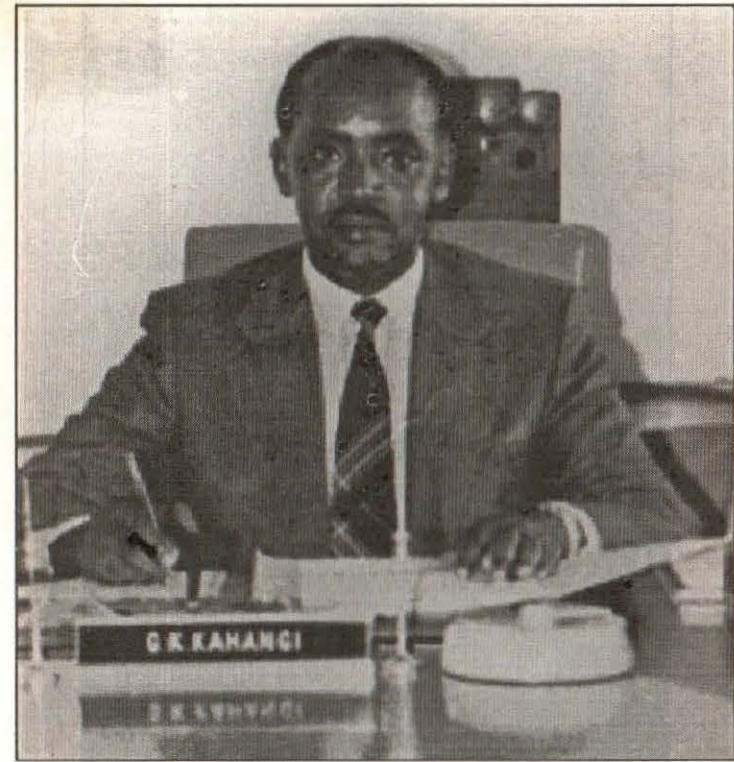


Mr. M.Y. G. Burua

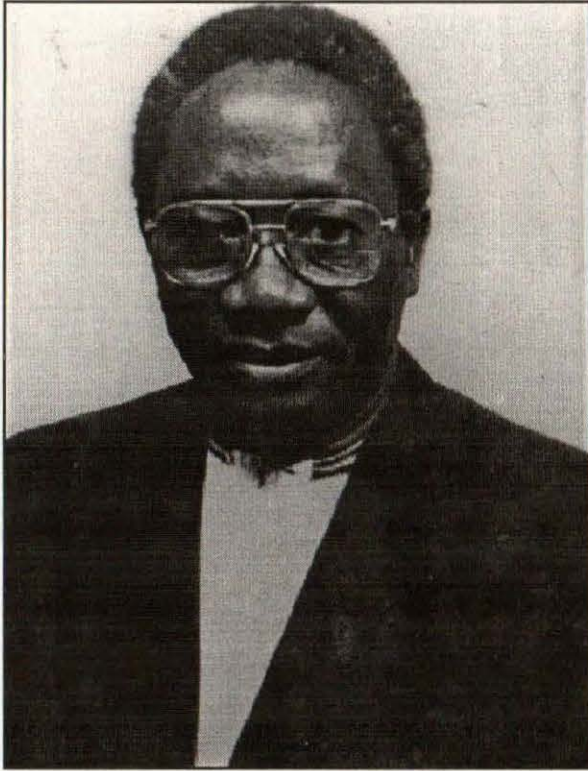
- ☞ He called for a more defined relationship between Kyambogo, Makerere University and the Ministry of Education.

Director Kyambogo NTC November 1981 - October 1985.

Mr. Kahangi was the last Director of Kyambogo NTC. The 1980s were years when there was an abrupt expansion of Secondary Schools across the country. This expansion demanded for an increase in the output of teachers. The College had to work hard to ensure that there was a steady supply. Thus in 1983 - 84 the first year in-take of 350 students was a landmark. The total enrolment was then 690 students. Mr. Kahangi like his predecessors called for a defined status of the college - an autonomous University College.

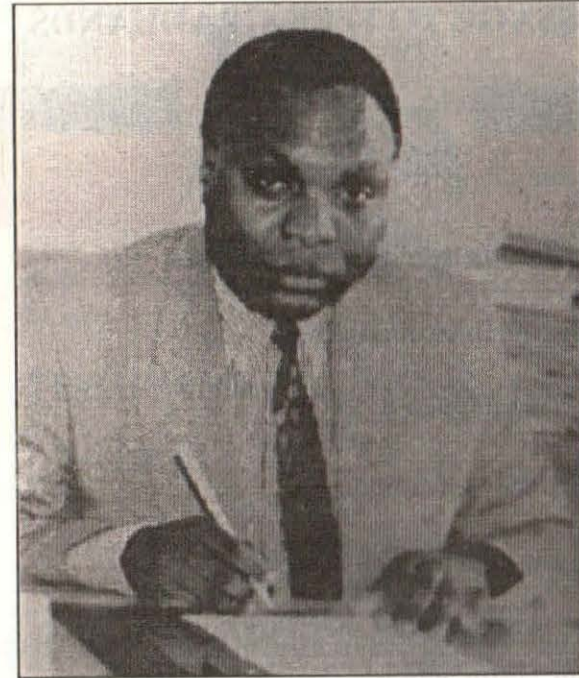


Prof William Senteza Kajubi
M.Sc. Ph.D.

Principal, Institute of Teacher Education Kyambogo 1986 - 1989.

Professor Senteza Kajubi was the first Principal of ITEK. His time was one of transition from the NTC to the present Institute Status of ITEK. This choice could not have been more appropriate; his name is almost synonymous with education. He has continued to keep a special place for ITEK in his schedule of work whenever he is called upon.

Professor Senteza Kajubi introduced **Child to Child** to ITEK. This is an approach to health education based on the belief that children are able to take an active part in promotion of their own health and that of their homes and communities. Child-to-Child has been integrated into the curriculum at ITEK and has spread across the country.



Prof.P.J.M. Ssebuwufu,

Prof. Ssebuwufu was the second Principal of ITEK. His task was to put physical and non physical structures of the Institute in place.

The first meeting of the Appointments Board was held on 7th November 1990. Addressing the Board on that day he said, " Today marks a turning point in the history of ITEK...". The first meeting of the Institute Council was held on 21st November, 1990. he had this to say on that occasion; "Your presence here today is of great historical significance in the history of this young Institution for you are its head and since its inception as an Institute of Teacher Education in 1986, it has operated without a head". The stage was now set for ITEK to expand, and during Prof. Ssebuwufu's time expansion of programmes at ITEK started.

His appointment as Vice Chancellor of Makerere University gave ITEK a patron in disguise.
