

The Vision is a code name for a four-year US\$ 900,00.00 project designed to improve teacher training at ITEK, the NTCs and the PTCs. It is a collaborative effort between the Institute of Teacher Education Kyambogo (ITEK), and the

Netherlands's Organisation for International Co-operation in Higher Education (NUFFIC). The gist of Project Vision is to improve quality in teacher training and ultimately quality of learning in the classroom. It is being funded through the Netherlands' Ministry for Development Co-operation, and under the *Development Co-operation and Education in the Nineties* programme.

OBJECTIVES

The following are considered to be the long-term objectives of **The Vision**. By the end of 2002, ITEK will have the capacity to:

A: Develop and execute new curricular for Diploma in Education Secondary (DES) and Bachelor of Education (B.Ed) - with emphasis on teaching and learning skills for lower secondary schools level and have the capacity to identify and transfer knowledge relevant to students.

B: Develop and execute new curricular for Diploma in Teacher Education (DTE) with emphasis on teaching and learning skills for tutor trainers for primary school level, and on classroom management. It will also have the capacity to identify and transfer knowledge relevant to students who will subsequently train teachers for primary school.

C: Set clear entry standards for tasks and duties of all teachers involved in primary and lower secondary education, including PTCs and NTCs. It will also have the capacity to set standards for the means they need to maintain and ensure sufficient quality.

It is hoped to achieve the above through the following short-term objectives:-

- Developing a Professional Profile (minimum standard) for a Ugandan Primary School Teacher (DEP).
- Developing a Professional Profile (minimum standard) for tutors of the PTCs (DTE).
- Working out a revised curriculum for a two-year

programme teacher training (DEP).

- Writing a revised curriculum for a two-year programme of tutor training (DTE).
- Designing educational workplaces to be used as training centres for DEP students and for tutor training.
- Designing pilots for PTCs to evaluate the dissemination of the DEP curriculum
- Helping the PTCs running the pilot programmes to evaluate the use of education workplaces.
- Producing staff that is trained not only to understand, but also to implement new concepts.
- Establishing a stable network to assist in dissemination and stabilization of the curricular.

ITEK has put a Core Team in place to steer the activities of Project: Vision. At an appropriate time (soon) it will get in touch with you and enable you to perform your role.

- Design, launch and run a Website on *The Vision*.
- Hold eight thematic and focused conferences in ITEK and elsewhere in the country.
- Hold a training workshop for NECAB.
- Carry out, with NECAB, a research to establish Teacher and Tutor Profiles.
- Hold curriculum review workshops.
- Try out recommendations for improvement.
- Monitor implementation of new changes in the curricular.
- Design and establish educational workplace models and publish a manual.
- Submit to the Ministry of Education and Sports Teacher and Tutor Profiles.
- Regularly publish a Newsletter, *The Vision*.
- Evaluate *The Vision* project.
- Publish a report based on the activities that took place over the four years (January 1, 2000 and December 31, 2003).

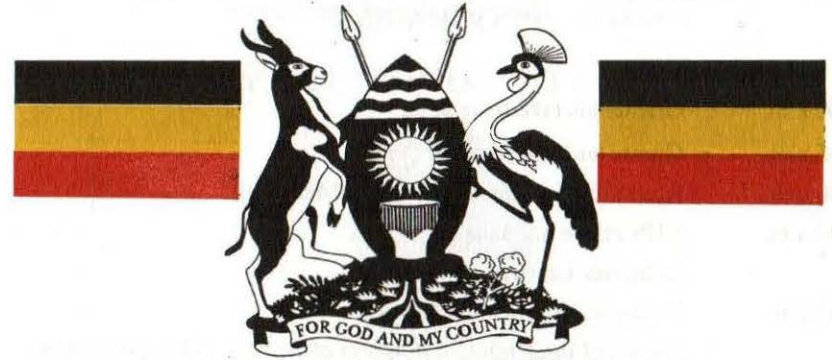

PRINCIPAL

It is a pleasant moment for me to welcome you once again to the Institute of Teacher Education Kyambogo on the occasion of the 10th Graduation ceremony. I thank God Almighty who has kept us alive to this day! Today, ITEK announces a contribution of 836 well trained and skilled men and women to the national labour force. ITEK's pledge to the nation is to train the human resource. For this we give glory to God.

ITEK is a large family, whose history dates back to 1948 when the student enrolment stood at only 15. The Institution whose beginning was that humble, has continued to grow both in number of students and staff, as well as academic and professional programmes offered. All the Primary and National Teachers' Colleges in Uganda and the Uganda National Institute for Special Education, UNISE, are connected to ITEK for academic and professional guidance: to ensure maintenance of high

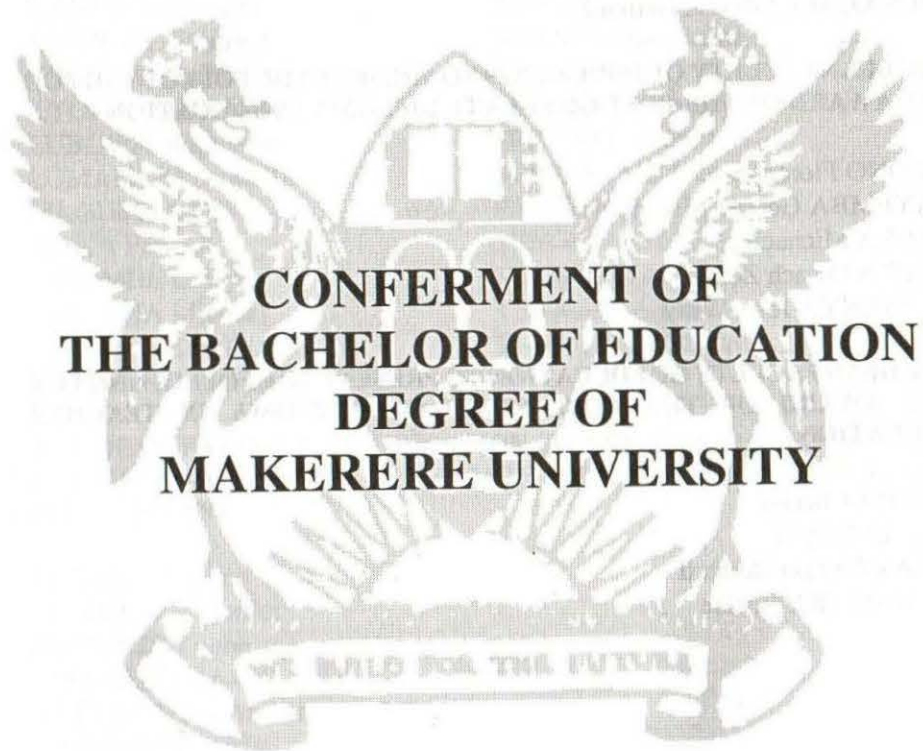

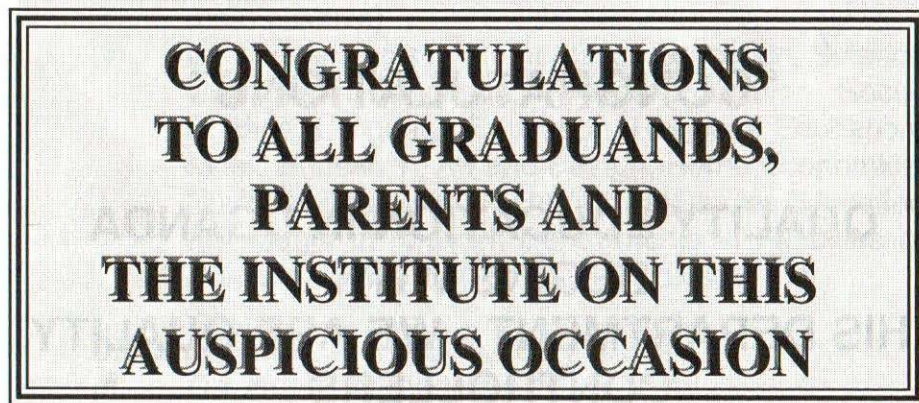

UNISE breaks barriers in learning

Graduates of Uganda National Institute of Special Education (UNISE) have gained competence and discipline, maximising access to learning for all children.

Established as a Department of Special Education at ITEK in 1988, UNISE has transformed, with the technical and financial support from Denmark in 1991, into a fully-fledged and autonomous Institute.

Its aim is to meet the great demand of special needs education in Uganda, and the Great Lakes Region through training teachers in the field of Special Needs Education, and personnel for Community Based Rehabilitation, and Mobility and Rehabilitation.

UNISE activities include training, research, production of technical and educational materials, production and dissemination of information. With the new international trends of inclusive education, UNISE has responded and taken up the challenge by modifying its programmes, for example introduction of a general Diploma in Special Needs Education.

The concept of special needs education has been redefined to go beyond the traditional disabilities like physical, hearing, visual impairment, and mental retardation. It now includes the following categories:

- gifted and talented children
- children living under difficult circumstances
- children who are terminally ill
- traumatised and abused children
- children living on the streets
- parenting children, and working children

UNISE enforces affirmative action and is gender and disability conscious. It has been designed with provisions for accessibility to all offices and rooms. It is a model to all other institutions and public buildings.

As part of the diversification programme, as well as meeting its vision and mission, UNISE has launched the Distance Learning Programme to ensure that more teachers and other personnel in the field of special needs education and rehabilitation are trained.

UNISE is also organising to host an international Conference on Community Based Rehabilitation in September 2001 under the theme: **“Community Based Rehabilitation as a Participatory Strategy in Africa.”** 100 participants will be drawn from Anglophone African countries and Europe.

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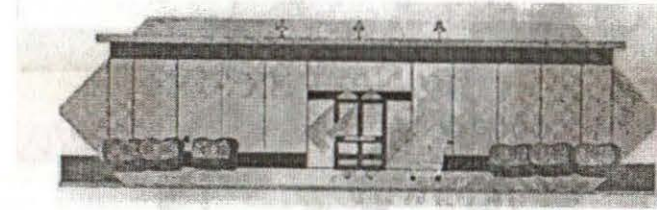
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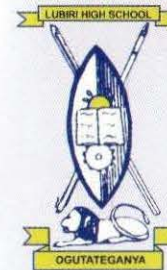
