Abstract

This study investigated the online information seeking behaviour of postgraduate engineering students at Kyambogo University in Uganda to determine the extent to which they use electronic (e-) library resources. A convergent mixed methods research approach was used. Quantitative data were collected from 58 out of 80 postgraduate engineering students using an online self-administered questionnaire while qualitative data were collected from interviews with 11 library staff and a focus group discussion


